Sliding Fee Scale

The sliding fee scale is available for individuals and families that are below 200% of the federal poverty guidelines that do not have access to Region funding assistance or probation vouchers. Treatment services eligible for the sliding fee scale include; Community Support, Individual Counseling, Group Counseling, Intensive Outpatient Program (IOP), Substance Use Disorder Assessment, and Initial Diagnostic Interview.
